Union Chapel Missionary Baptist Church was established on October 4, 1933 in the home of Rev. O. D. Boone and wife Lucy Boone. Their home was located on Blue Spring Road in Huntsville, Alabama. Worship services were held in several temporary locations over the next thirteen years. The first permanent worship building was located in **“The Grove”** at 536 Gardner Street. As we continue our celebration of 92 years of establishment, we invite families to visit the Historical Marker that tells the story of Union Chapel Missionary Baptist Church. The marker is located in **“The Grove”** at the corner of Lowe Avenue SW and Dr. Joseph E. Lowery Boulevard. * For families that can't visit “The Grove” location, we are blessed to have a duplicate marker on **“The Hill.”** Celebrate our 92 years of establishment by visiting the markers, taking photographs and thanking God for our rich heritage of worshiping and serving the people of the Huntsville and Madison County areas.
