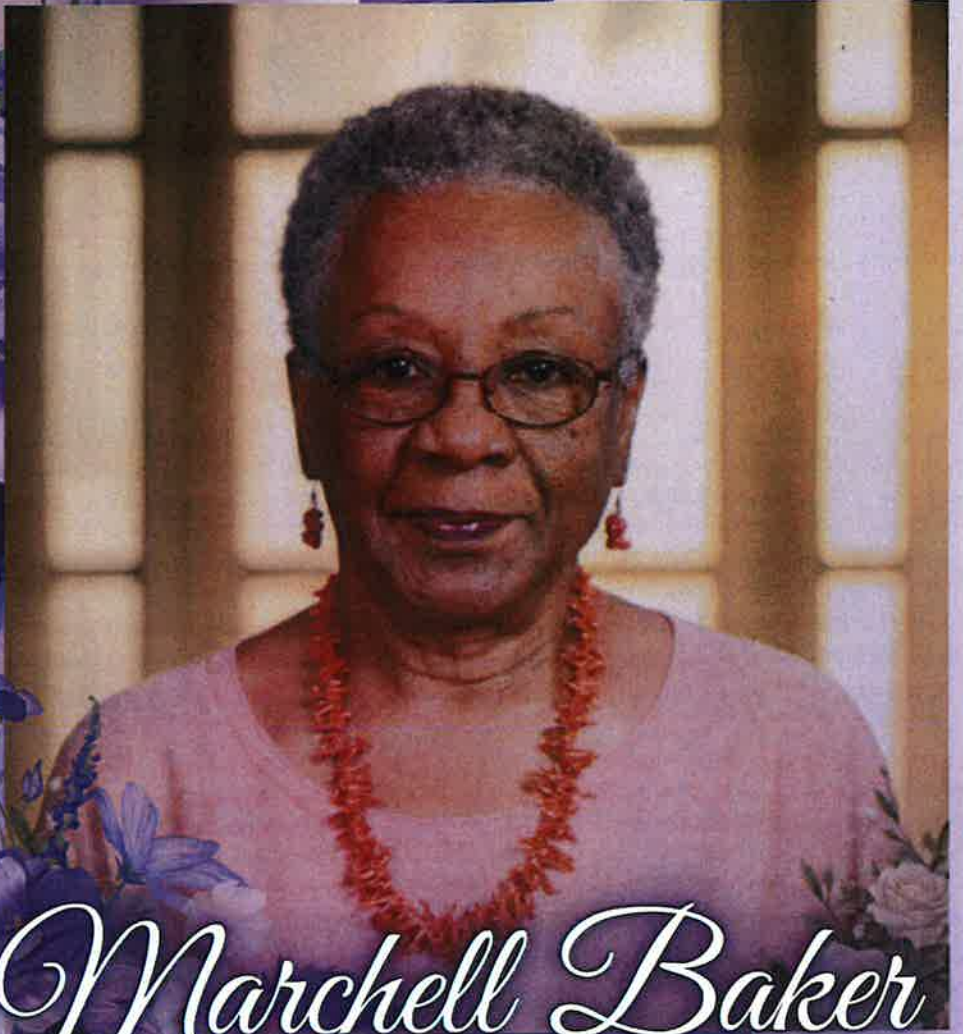

Celebrating the Life and Legacy of Marchell A. Baker

It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of Marchell Ann Baker, who departed this world on January 22, 2026, in Huntsville, Alabama. Born on August 27, 1952, Marchell was a beloved member of the Baker and Moore family, a devoted friend, and a respected member of the community.

Marchell was the youngest of ten children born to the late Will Baker, Sr., and Ollie Mae (Moore) Baker. She confessed her faith in Christ at an early age at Cedar Grove Methodist Church in Huntsville, Alabama. Marchell attended Council Training School, which was the last class prior to desegregation, and then graduated from Sparkman High School in 1970. She continued her education at Alabama Agricultural & Mechanical University (AAMU) where she earned her Bachelor of Arts degree in Special Education and a Master of science in organization development and Human Resources from John Hopkins University. Her life was marked by kindness, generosity, and an unwavering commitment to those around her. Known for her warm smile and compassionate nature, Marchell touched the lives of all those who knew her and leaves behind a legacy of love and cherished memories.

Marchell was inducted into the Alpha Omega Chapter of Eta Phi Beta Sorority in Huntsville, Alabama. She retired from the FDIC as Assistant Director, where she received the Mission Achievement Award and the Special Act of Service Award. She received an honorable discharge from the U.S. Army in 1979. She served as the Deputy Director for the U.S. Army Bomb Squad, where she received the Commander's Award for Civilian Service. Marchell was a lifetime member of the Alabama A&M University Alumni Association.

Throughout her life, Marchell excelled in her career, hobbies, and passions, inspiring others with her dedication and enthusiasm, especially her nieces and nephews. She was also actively involved in numerous community organizations and volunteer work. As an active member of Union Chapel M. B. Church, she sang in the choir, taught bible classes, and served her church family, always striving to make a positive impact. As a faithful servant of God, loving daughter, and caring sister, Marchell leaves a legacy of memories to those to who cherished her: her sister, Ruby J. Pope (Ohio) and her brother, Will Baker, Jr. (Shirley Ann) (Alabama).
